GENTLEMEN:

We mail you herewith blank return of valuation of property in your town. We send thus early because it is of great importance that they be returned as soon as they can be after you have made your valuation for this year.

The law requires us to have our report made and filed by December first. We can plead no excuse for not doing it.

With the amount of work involved we MUST have the returns of town assessors as soon as we can get them after the valuations are made, in order that we may complete our report on time.

Make your valuation on a full fair cash basis, and give us all the information you can. No returns made on a percentage basis of less than 100 per cent, will be accepted.

Give full descriptions of property and values in right hand column of sheet. All logs cut and lying in unincorporated places, or in transit on the first day of April, if owned by a single individual, are taxable in the city or town where the owner of same resides at that time. If owned by a company are taxable where they are manufactured.

Sect. 3 of Chap. 6 (Revised Statutes), according to the opinion of the Attorney General, includes buildings on other's land and such property should be scheduled and taxed as real estate.

As we shall this year make an equalization of the valuation of all the towns in the State, it is very important that all town property, and all exempted property (excepting school-houses,) shall be returned to us at its full fair cash value.

Give total number of polls whether exempted or not.

If anything occurs to you that you think you cannot fully state on the return, append any statement you desire.

Fill out the enclosed postal card and return at once, so that we may know that you have received the blank return.
